I will notify the church if I feel there is any health considerations that would prevent my child's participation in any of the activities listed above. I also give my permission for church leaders to restrict my child from participating in any activity if they should doubt my child's ability or safety while participating.

Central Church of Christ 2009 Code of Conduct

The following list of guidelines is our "Code of Conduct." These Rules and Regulations are instituted to ensure the safety of all participants; youth and adults alike. Please review these rules with your student before departure and sign this sheet, acknowledging that you have read and understand these rules.

1. Each student is expected to follow directions and the rules and regulations established by the leaders prior to and during the trip.
2. The Students shall not be involved in any way with smoking, alcohol, illegal drugs, vandalism, theft, or any other type of behavior that is judged by the sponsors to be detrimental to the health, well-being, safety, or reputation of him/herself, or any one else in the group including the sponsors.
3. Students will never leave the group by themselves. If a student wishes to leave the group, they must get permission from a sponsor.
4. Students will show respect for sponsors, other students, and other people that are encountered on the trip. Disrespect for other people, their property, the use of profanity or other inappropriate language is unacceptable.
5. P.D.A., or "public displays of affection" are not allowed on youth trips. Any physical conduct deemed inappropriate by the sponsors will not be tolerated. Girls will ride in Girl seats and Guys will ride in Guy seats.
6. A dress code will be in effect on this trip. This is a Christian event, and clothing should be modest, conservative, and appropriate. If clothing is deemed inappropriate, the student will be requested to change.
7. CD, Mp3, Ipods, DVD or Tape players are not allowed. If you have one of these items on the trip it will be taken from you. However you may bring Christian Music that can be played through the main stereo system on these devices.
8. Secular books or magazines are not allowed. Homework is ok.
9. We will no longer allow cell phones on youth trips. If you need to get a hold of your parents or your parents need to get a hold of you, you will be allowed to use the sponsor phones that will be on the trip. If you have a cell phone on the trip it will be taken from you and returned at the end of the trip or when the sponsor chooses.

Failure to obey any of the preceding rules can result in dismissal from the event. The parents of the students will then be responsible to pick up their child in a timely manner from the event. By signing below, both the parent and student acknowledge that they have read the code of conduct and understand its content. Signing also agrees to responsibility if there is a disciplinary action that needs to be taken.
